- A. Residential Customers that agree to a three years service agreement are entitled to the following bundled package of services:

Two Telephone Access Lines with two different telephone numbers (Note 1).

Elite Calling Features (as outlined in Section 12.1(C)).

Unlimited local and toll calling in the United States, including Alaska and Hawaii.

Digital Subscriber Lines Service on one telephone access line, as outlined in NECA FCC Tariff No.4, Section17 at a speed of no less than 640k down and 120k up.

Inside Wire Maintenance Package

Rate - \$99.99 per month.

Optional – Customer may upgrade the speed of the Digital Subscriber Line service to 1544k up and 512k down for an additional \$30 per month.

The Company will allow customers to terminate service before the three year service agreement expires under the following circumstances:

- (A) The customer no longer has their main principal residency in the company's service territory.
- (B) Customer that currently did not qualify for lifeline assistance when the service agreement was entered into becomes eligible under either the federal or the state qualifications.
- (C) The company cannot provide any of the listed services above.

This rate does not include federal or state mandated taxes and surcharges such as federal excise tax, state excise tax, E911 surcharge, Federal Universal Service Charge or local municipal imposed taxes.

Note 1 –At the customer's request or in certain areas where the company may not have sufficient facilities to offer two telephone lines, the customer may select Double Number Ring, which allows the telephone set to have two distinct ring tones on the same line.

Charges for services provisioned by T-1 lines and other advanced services shall mirror Cambridge Telephone Company's application of 9-1-1 charges. The assessment on prepaid wireless transactions is established at .07% of the prepaid retail transaction, to be implemented by the Illinois Department of Revenues. These charges shall be effective with bills rendered on or after July 1, 2019 or at the beginning of the first cycle after July 1, 2019.
